Depot Locations & Pick-Up Timing

- Motorhome depots are usually just off the airport, with a complimentary shuttle service available.
- Last vehicle pick-up is generally at 3 pm
- If arriving in the afternoon, we recommend an overnight stay at an airport hotel before collecting the motorhome the next day

Booking & Payment Info

- Deposit = 20% of vehicle cost (in addition to ANZCRO's \$110pp deposit)
- Deposit is required at time of booking or deposit if within cancellation window

THL Roadtrip App

- Highly recommended for all motorhome travellers!

Key Features:

- GPS Location Services: Nearest campsites, dump stations, petrol stations, toilets, supermarkets, and LPG fill-up points

Camper Videos:

- Walkthrough videos of each camper type
- CamperHelp videos for practical tips (e.g. plug in power, use toilet cassette)
- Offline Maps: Save maps to use without internet/data
- Community Tips: Read reviews and advice from fellow travellers

Encourage clients to download before travel!

Depots are usually just off airport – with a complimentary shuttle available. Generally last pick up is 3pm, so we recommend an overnight at airport hotel prior to pick up when arriving in the afternoon

Taking a Motorhome on the Ferry (NZ)

Operators:

- **Interislander** and **Bluebridge** ferries run between: Wellington (North Island) ↔ Picton (South Island)

THL Vehicle Policy:

- Maui, Britz & Mighty allow their vehicles on the ferry.
- You are not required to switch vehicles between islands (unlike some older policies)
- You must book ferry travel in advance, especially in peak season

Booking Tip: When booking a ferry, you'll need

- Vehicle type (e.g. campervan/motorhome)
- Vehicle length (THL will advise this on booking)
- Passenger details

Cost:

- The fare includes both passengers + vehicle
- Prices vary depending on the time of year and ferry company

Optional Add-Ons & Excess Reduction

- Standard insurance excess for motorhomes can be significant
- We highly recommend purchasing an excess reduction option (buy-down) to lower liability
- Additional packs are available to include accessories and coverage for extra fees

Additional Info:

There are different packs that can be added onto the base rate to include excess reduction and additional accessories & fees. Insurance excess is large with a Motorhome, so we do recommend purchasing the buy down to reduce it.
